- Teach and encourage the children to do their best and to achieve their full potential as a valued member of the school community;
- Develop in each child positive values and a caring attitude towards the school community and the environment;
- Set and monitor regular homework;
- Be welcoming and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the life of the school;
- Contact you as soon as concerns are raised about your child's work, behaviour, attendance or punctuality;
- Have a clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions.

Parent

As a parent/carer I will:

- Be committed to support the school's mission statement, ethos and values;
- Be committed to ensure that my child achieves a high level of attendance (minimum 96%) and not take children out of school during term time;
- Ensure my child gets enough sleep before school;
- Make sure that my child is punctual and properly equipped and ready to learn;
- Ensure that my child wears the correct school uniform;
- Inform the school if my child is absent by telephone on first day of absence;
- Raise any concerns or problems that might affect my child's ability to learn or behave appropriately;
- Support my child with homework and listen to my child read regularly;
- Support the school by encouraging my child to develop a positive attitude towards our diverse, multi-cultural community;
- Attend meetings with my child's teacher and other staff, aiming to be positive and productive, working towards moving my child on in their learning;
- Support the school to make sure my child maintains good behaviour;
- Read all information sent home as this gives me important details of relevant policies, meetings, activities, newsletters and open days;
- Inform the school immediately of any changes to parent/carer and emergency contact details;
- Respect all members of the school community in meetings, by correspondence and on social media;
- Support the school approach to online safety including the restriction of age restricted games and access to technology at night time.
- Take an active and supportive part in school events including those that fall outside the school day.
